**III. ELECTION OF A COMMITTEE MEMBER TO CHAIR THE COMMITTEE**  
*(Discussion/For Possible Action)*

Dr. Mausling nominated Dr. Perlotto to Chair the Committee. No other nominations were received. Dr. Mausling made a motion for Dr. Perlotto to be appointed chair of this Legislative Committee; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board voted unanimously to appoint Dr. Perlotto as the Chair of the Legislative Committee.

**IV. DISCUSSION/CONSIDERATION/ACTION REGARDING LEGISLATIVE BILLS-** *The Committee will review and discuss the following bills. The Committee may vote to take a position on behalf of the Board to remain neutral, to support, or not support each bill- (Discussion/For Possible Action)*

- a. *AB 7-*After some discussion the Board decided to oppose AB 7. Dr. Mausling made a motion to oppose AB 7; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to oppose AB 7.
- b. *AB 11-* After some discussion the Board decided to oppose AB 11. Dr. Mausling made a motion to oppose AB 11; seconded by Dr. Daulat. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to oppose AB 11.
- c. *AB 37-* After some discussion the Board decided to support AB 37. Dr. Perlotto made a motion to support AB 37; seconded by Dr. Mausling. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to support AB 37.
- d. *AB 45-* After some discussion the Board decided to support AB 45. Dr. Mausling made a motion to support AB 45; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to support AB 45.
- e. *AB 108-* After some discussion the Board decided to support AB 108. Dr. Mausling made a motion to support AB 108; seconded by Dr. Daulat. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to support AB 108.
- f. *AB 115-* After some discussion the Board decided to stay neutral on AB 115. Dr. Mausling made a motion to neutral on AB 115; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to stay neutral on AB 115.
- g. *AB 156-* After some discussion, the Board decided to support AB 156 if the provision in section 12(2)(a) of the bill is amended to allow the osteopathic physician or physician assistant to opt out of offering to prescribe the medication and instead follow the provisions set forth in section 12(2)(b) of the bill. If that provision is not so amended, then the Board decided to oppose AB 156. Dr. Mausling made a motion; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to support the bill if the amendment is made as set forth above and to oppose the bill if such amendment to the bill is not made.
- h. *AB 158-* After some discussion the Board decided to support AB 158. Dr. Mausling made a motion to support AB 158; seconded by Dr. Daulat. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to support AB 158.
- i. *AB 196-* After some discussion the Board decided to oppose AB 196. Dr. Mausling made a motion to oppose AB 196; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to oppose AB 196.
- j. *AB 244-* After some discussion the Board decided to stay neutral on AB 244. Dr. Perlotto made a motion to stay neutral on AB 244; seconded by Dr. Mausling. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to stay neutral on AB 244.
- k. *AB 268-* After some discussion the Board decided to stay neutral on AB 268. Dr. Perlotto made a motion to support AB 268; seconded by Dr. Mausling. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to stay neutral AB 268.
- l. *AB 270-* After some discussion the Board decided to support AB 270. Dr. Mausling made a motion to support AB 270; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to support AB 270.
- m. *AB 276-* After some discussion the Board decided to support AB 276. Dr. Mausling made a motion to support AB 276; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to support AB 276.

- n. *AB 318*- After some discussion the Board decided to stay neutral on AB 318. Dr. Perlotto made a motion to stay neutral on AB 318; seconded by Dr. Mausling. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to stay neutral on AB 318.
- o. *AB 364*- After some discussion the Board decided to oppose AB 364. Dr. Mausling made a motion to oppose AB 364; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to oppose AB 364.
- p. *SB 302*- After some discussion the Board decided to stay neutral on SB 302. Dr. Perlotto made a motion to stay neutral on SB 302; seconded by Dr. Mausling. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to stay neutral on SB 302.
- q. *SB 336*- After some discussion the Board decided to stay neutral on SB 336. Dr. Mausling made a motion to stay neutral on SB 336; seconded by Dr. Perlotto. There being no further discussion, the Board unanimously approved the motion to stay neutral on SB336.

The Board noted that a vote to oppose the bill is equivalent to a vote to not support the bill.
