**3. Presentation and Discussion of Proposed Regulations**

Staff of the Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine (Board) will provide background on the purpose and the need for the proposed amendments/additions to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 633, specifically regarding requirements for the Board to establish a process for prioritizing the review of an application for initial licensure if the applicant demonstrates that he or she will provide health care primarily in a historically underserved community; requirements for the Board to establish a procedure for prioritizing osteopathic physician license applications of applicants who plan to serve underserved geographic areas or populations or practice a specialty for which there is a shortage in this State; requirement to establishment of electronic systems to expedite the verification of credentials of providers of health care for the purposes of inclusion in insurance networks and serving on the staff of hospitals; and requirement for certain reports to be submitted by the Board to the Governor and Legislature.

Executive Director Frank DiMaggio provided background on the proposed regulations, which are required by Assembly Bill 483 (passed in the 2025 regular session) and Senate Bill 5 (passed in the 36th special session of 2025).

The amendments aim to prioritize licensure reviews for applicants serving historically underserved communities, geographic areas, populations, or shortage specialties; establish electronic systems for credential verification; and require reports to the Governor and Legislature. A small business impact statement was conducted, with inquiries sent out around February 13, 2026, and no responses to the email inquiries were received as of the workshop date, March 4, 2026. Board Counsel Micheline Fairbank had no comments regarding this matter.
